He also holds a Master's and Bachelor's degree in Saxophone Performance from the Superior Conservatory of Salamanca (Spain). Juan Carlos taught several master classes in different European countries such as Norway, Finland, Spain and the United States.

Along his performance trajectory, Juan Carlos has played concerts internationally in Norway, Denmark, Latvia, Andorra, and Croatia, and has performed at the Navy Band International Saxophone Symposium, American Saxophone Academy, University of the Pacific, San Francisco Conservatory of Music, Manhattan School of Music, the Helsinki Music Center. He has played as a soloist with the Sibelius Academy Symphony Orchestra, Youth Orchestra of Salamanca (Spain), Helsinki Saxophone Orchestra, SaxibA Ensemble. He has also attended many workshops with well known musicians, such as Claude Delangle, Arno Bornkamp, Timothy McAllister, Otis Murphy, Marcus Weiss, Vincent David, Jean Denis Michat, to name a few.
