

The Loca Saxophone Quartet was founded by Joshua Hebert (soprano saxophone), Collin Juniper (alto saxophone), Sophia Flores (tenor saxophone), and Julianna Townley (baritone saxophone). Originating as a collaboration among students at the University of Southern California, the ensemble has since grown well beyond its academic roots into an active and emerging professional chamber group.

Loca is recognized for its commitment to championing new music and expanding the saxophone quartet repertoire. The ensemble has premiered numerous works, including *Saxophone Music* by Luc Edouard and *Fog Run* by Brenden McBrien, and has collaborated closely with some of today's leading composers, including Henryk Golden, Luc Edouard, Joey Sellars, Carter Pann, and Frank Ticheli. These collaborations reflect Loca's dedication to amplifying innovative voices and engaging audiences with contemporary and compelling repertoire.

An active performing ensemble, the Loca Saxophone Quartet appears frequently at events throughout California and has performed at venues across the United States. Recent highlights include performances at the 2025 NASA Region 2 Conference and the Navy Band Saxophone Symposium in Fairfax, Virginia. Praised for its technical mastery, stylistic versatility, and adventurous programming, Loca continues to establish itself as a dynamic new voice in the chamber music landscape.
